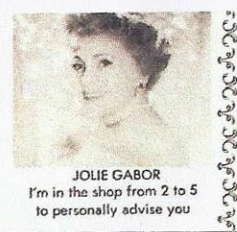


A Look Back:

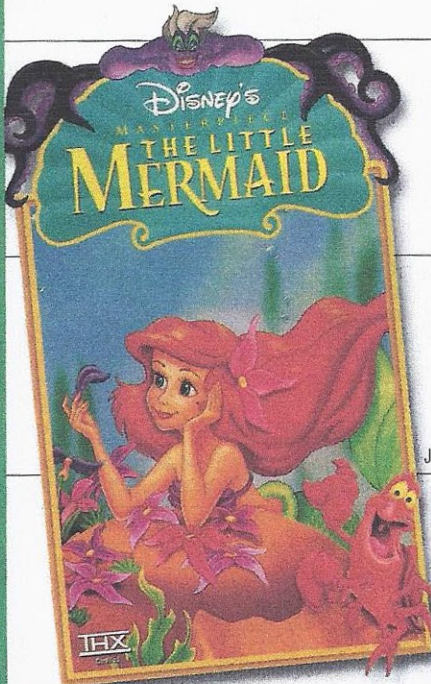
